In recent years, consumption of alcohol has been rising steadily in British Columbia and in Canada as a whole. In Canada, alcohol sales per adult have increased by over 11% in the past decade. An analysis of the 2004 Canadian Addiction Survey found that a substantial proportion of alcohol is consumed in excess of Canadian guidelines, placing BC drinkers at elevated risk for short and/or long-term harm. Alcohol consumption and hazardous drinking are highly relevant from a public health perspective. Research has shown a strong positive correlation between drinking levels and patterns of alcohol use and alcohol related harm. In fact, BC has seen an increase in the number of alcohol-related deaths, Canada Goose Chilliwack Bomber, injuries and illnesses in the province. It follows that alcohol consumption is placing an increasingly heavy social and economic burden on the province. The total estimated costs of alcohol abuse in BC are at \$2.2 billion per annum, considerably higher than those associated with illicit substance use. Justification for Raising Prices Once Again.
