At first, you need to ensure that your grip is much weaker for pitch shots. This will prevent your hands from rolling over the grip, which will affect the control of the ball. For pitching, try Using a Callaway XR Fairway Wood for sale or a lower lofted sand wedge. Next, open up your stance and set your feet closer to the ball. Set the ball further back in your stance, the further back, the steeper the trajectory of the ball upon impact.

In addition, a completely different shot to pitching will also be helpful. The ball is chipped up in the air for only a short period of time. It then travels a greater distance as the TaylorMade Rsi 1 Irons for sale runs along the green towards the pin. It's a relatively easy shot, one that utilizes very few moving body parts.

Finally, you can try to practice your lob shot. Some may think taylormade m2 irons for sale is one of the most difficult short-game shots, but on the other hand, it is the most useful shot. Because it will enable you to get up and down easily, without the ball
