A
ex-police officer who seem to killed an disarmed Black man in his Dallas apartment includes
filed an appeal on her behalf conviction.

On Sept 6, 2018, Silpada Guyger shot plus
killed 26-year-old Botham Jean. While in the 2019 trial, Guyger's attorneys asserted that she
parked to the wrong floor with her building searching for long shift on the job and mistakenly got
into the apartment above her very own.

Insider previously reported anytime Guyger
walked on the wrong apartment the woman saw the silhouette on the figure standing at night
and said "Let me see the hands! " before taking her firearm.

Prosecutors compared
with that argument, saying Jean wasn't a threat when he was watching tv and eating your bowl
of ice-cubes cream when Guyger got into his Dallas flat.

Ultimately, she was
determined guilty of Jean's hard and sentenced to few years in prison around October 2019.
While in the appeal, Guyger is inquiring to either be acquitted of your murder charge and also
acquitted and costed with criminally negligent murder, a lesser felony. Guyger's lawyers said
the fact that evidence was "legally not sufficient to prove above reasonable doubt, inches CBS
reported.

"Her incorrect belief negated a culpability for hard because although the
woman intentionally and knowingly prompted Jean's death, she had the ideal to act around
deadly force around self-defense since the girl's belief that unsafe force was straight away
necessary was reasonable in the circumstances, " Guyger's attorneys said while in the appeal.
